SUBJECT:	Closure of "Window" for Personal Contributions by Lobbyists to Candidates for Legislative Office

On June 8, 2022, Governor Evers issued <u>Executive Order #168</u> convening a Special Session of the Wisconsin Legislature at 12:00 p.m. on Wednesday, June 22, 2022.

WIS. STAT. § 13.625(1m)(b) provides in relevant part:

13.625 Prohibited Practices

... (1m)

(b) A lobbyist may make a personal contribution to a partisan elective state official or candidate for partisan elective state office or to the candidate committee of the official or candidate between the first day authorized by law for the circulation of nomination papers as a candidate at a general election or special election, except that:

 A contribution to a candidate for legislative office may be made during that period only if the legislature has concluded its final floorperiod, and is not in special or extraordinary session.
A contribution by a lobbyist to the lobbyist's candidate committee for

2. A contribution by a lobbyist to the lobbyist's candidate committee for partisan elective state office may be made at any time.

Pursuant to <u>WIS. STAT. § 13.625(1m)(b)1.</u>, lobbyists may not make personal contributions to candidates for legislative office while the Legislature is in special session. Therefore, the window for personal contributions from lobbyists closes at 12:00 p.m. on Wednesday, June 22, 2022. The window will remain closed until the Special Session is adjourned. Both direct personal contributions and personal contributions made through a conduit are prohibited. Once the Special Session is adjourned, the Ethics Commission will provide notice that the "window" has reopened.

Lobbyists and conduits should take special care not to make or deliver lobbyists' personal contributions to legislative candidates while the window is closed. Additionally, legislative candidate committees should take special care to not accept such contributions while the window is closed.
