CAMPAIGN FINANCE CHECKLIST FOR 2024 PARTISAN COUNTY CANDIDATES

Candidates for partisan county office should determine if they are required to make financial disclosure reports.

If NOT claiming the exemption from reporting requirements:

The filing officer for partisan county candidates is the county clerk, except in Milwaukee County where the filing officer is the Milwaukee County Board of Election Commissioners. Candidates should contact their filing officer for further information or to obtain any of the necessary forms. WIS. STATS. §§ 11.0102(1)(b), 11.0102(3)(c)

Obtain a copy of the <i>Campaign Finance Overview</i> – <i>Local Candidates</i> Manual (Revised 2023) from your filing officer and carefully review it with your treasurer.
Complete and submit a <i>July Continuing Campaign Finance Report</i> (Form CF-2L) to the filing officer no later than July 15, 2024 . This report covers activity from January 1, 2024, or the date of registration (whichever is later), through June 30, 2024. WIS. STATS. §§ 11.0204(4)(d) 11.0103(3)(a)2.
Complete and submit a <i>Pre-Primary Campaign Finance Report</i> (Form CF-2L) to the filing officer no later than August 5 , 2024 . This report covers activity from July 1, 2024, through July 29, 2024. WIS. STATS. §§ <u>11.0204(4)(a)</u> , <u>11.0103(3)(a)1</u> .
Complete and submit a September Continuing Campaign Finance Report (Form CF-2L) to the filing officer no later than September 30, 2024 . This report covers activity from July 30, 2024, through September 23, 2024. WIS. STATS. §§ 11.0204(4)(e) 11.0103(3)(a)4.
Complete and submit a <i>Pre-Election Campaign Finance Report</i> (Form CF-2L) to the filing officer no later than October 28, 2024 . This report covers activity from September 24, 2024, through October 21, 2024. Wis. STATS. §§ 11.0204(4)(b), 11.0204(5)(a), 11.0103(3)(a)1.
Complete and submit a <i>January Continuing Campaign Finance Report</i> (Form CF-2L) to the filing officer no later than January 15, 2025 . This covers activity from October 22, 2024, through December 31, 2024. Wis. STATS. §§ 11.0204(4)(c),11.0204(5)(b), 11.0103(3)(a)2.

Note: Candidates are required to continue filing Campaign Finance Reports, regardless of the results of the Primary or Election. Wis. STAT. §11.0207. An individual that has won the election and holding office is defined as a candidate, and therefore must remain registered and cannot terminate while in office. Wis. STATS. §§11.0202(1)(a), 11.0101(1)(b)
