FALL ELECTION CANDIDATES AT THE COUNTY LEVEL

TWO COMMISSIONS: ETHICS AND ELECTIONS

There are three major components needed for County-level Fall Election candidates to get on the ballot:

- Registration as a candidate committee (Ethics Commission)
- Filing nomination papers (Elections Commission);
- Filing a Declaration of Candidacy form (Elections Commission).

BASIC INFORMATION

<u>Include in your candidate packet:</u> A link to (or copy of) the Ballot Access Checklist for the appropriate type of office. Ballot access checklists can be found via the links above.

REGISTERING A CANDIDATE COMMITTEE

Each candidate and current officeholder must have a committee.

The local filing officer collects the registration form, files it, and makes it available for public inspection.

A candidate committee must be registered as soon as a candidate raises or spends any money (even their own money), submits nomination papers, or accepts nomination by caucus. Candidate committee registration forms must be submitted no later the deadline for filing nomination papers.

REGISTERING A CANDIDATE COMMITTEE EXEMPT STATUS

If a candidate committee will not exceed \$2,000 in activity in a calendar year, they may register as "exempt." Exempt committees do not have to file campaign finance reports.

All other committees must file campaign finance reports until the committee is terminated or goes on exempt status.

This page includes links to reporting forms and manuals, plus information on filing deadlines, contribution limits, and attribution statements (also called disclaimers or "paid for by" statements).



DECLARATION OF CANDIDACY

The Declaration of Candidacy ("DOC") form can be filed at any time before the deadline for submitting nomination papers or the deadline for accepting nomination by caucus.

The DOC is usually combined with a Memorandum Regarding Felony Convictions, although some offices may file the memo separately.

<u>Include in your candidate packet:</u> A link to (or copy of) the EL-162 Declaration of Candidacy form and (if not included), the Memorandum Regarding Felony Convictions. Links:

Nomination Process

Partisan county officials elected in the Fall Election must file nomination papers. The candidate will have to circulate and submit the required number of signatures.
